

Visitation Policy Effective February 2022



General Visitation Hours 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.



****MASKS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL AREAS OF THE HOSPITAL. Individuals should NOT enter the building if they have recently or are currently experiencing any of the listed COVID symptoms listed upon entry point****

- **NON-COVID patients:** Only TWO visitors at a time are allowed in a patient's room. Overnight stays are only approved if necessary for participation in the patient's care. No children under the age of 13 are allowed to visit.
- **COVID or suspected COVID patients:** One designated visitor allowed per day. The visitor must adhere to PPE requirements of the hospital and remain in the room. Once the visitor exits the room, they may only return the following day, no reentry allowed. Visitors may be asked to leave during certain procedures/therapies in accordance with the CDC high risk exposure guidelines.
- **Same Day Surgery:** Only one visitor will be allowed with a patient. Parents/Caregivers are allowed if the patient is under the age of 18.
- **Outpatient Procedures:** One support person, parent of a minor or caregiver will be allowed to wait in the waiting room until the patient is discharged.
- **Lake Haven Behavioral Unit:** Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesdays and Sundays only.

Entrance Locations and Hours to HCMC:

- **Emergency Department Entrance**-Open 24 hours/day 7 days per week
- **Patient Parking Lot/Bridge entrance**-Open 5 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday-Friday; closed Saturday and Sunday
- **Front Circle Entrance**-Open 5 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday -Friday; closed Saturday and Sunday.
